<b>DECISION</b>	After the application deadline, it takes about 6-8 weeks to announce the decision. Decisions are made by the individual departments.	
<b>TANSCRIPT OF RECORDS</b>	A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution after the assessment period has finished. This can take up to 8 weeks.
