<b>LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT</b>	German - no specific level*)	*) <b>Basic knowledge</b> of the <b>German</b> language is strongly recommended, as lectures are usually held in German. Especially for Dept. <b>Graphics and Advertising</b> , <b>German knowledge</b> in level <b>B1-B2</b> is highly appreciated! Attending a German course before and during the exchange in Vienna is strongly recommended. At least, <b>we expect</b> a profound knowledge of <b>English (B2)</b> from all students.
<b>LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION</b>	<b>German</b> (some lectures are in English)	
<b>DECISION</b>	After the application deadline, it takes about 6-8 weeks to announce the decision. Decisions are made by the individual departments.	
<b>TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS</b>	A <u>Transcript of Records</u> will be issued by the receiving institution after the assessment period has finished. This can take <u>up to 8 weeks</u> .
