

Recognition of foreign degrees

Admission to the master programme TransArts

Requirements

General university entrance qualification

- a. An **entrance examination** to prove your artistic aptitude
- b. Graduation of a subject-relevant study to the extent of at least 180 ECTS or completion of an artistic master study programme to the extent of least 120 ECTS at an art university or tertiary educational institution

Graduates of the “TransArts” bachelor programme are qualified for the “TransArts” master programme and do not require an entrance examination.

As **evidence** for the equivalence of a study programme, you have to provide

- the **original**
(where required with apostille or full public certification, depending on the country of origin)

and

- a **translation** into German or English language with public certification, if you are not a citizen from a member country of the European Union (or an equated country, e.g. Switzerland)

of the following **documents**:

- final degree
- degree supplement, including a list of all courses attended (with grades and ECTS)
- record of study (start/end of study programme, periods of leave etc.)

Procedure

Your application for admission to the master programme TransArts will be processed as soon as you have provided all required documents, but not before the start of admission period. Original documents will be checked and returned at once.

Statements in advance, whether your foreign degrees are sufficient for admission, can only be informal and will not influence the final decision.
